

Public Policy Framework for the Implementation of the UN Sustainable Development Goals after 2015 - the Role of the Government of Serbia Ministries and specific Independent State Bodies







The document is the product of the Project "Advocacy of Sustainable Development Goals after 2015", in which the Fund for an Open Society and SeConS- development initiative group have analysed the compliance of the basic framework of Serbia public policies for the realization of the Sustainable Development Goals currently proposed for the agenda of the United Nations after 2015.

The following text sets out the relation between Sustainable Development Goals and:

- the ministries of the Republic of Serbia Government and specific independent state bodies (It also sets out how many various Sustainable Development Goals each individual ministry/specific independent state body is competent for)
- valid or proposed strategies of the Republic of Serbia Government

In the first case, the relation between the targets of each of the 17 proposed Sustainable Development Goals and relevant competencies of the ministries/specific independent state bodies, as defined by the Law on the ministries, Law on Ombudsman, Law on Prohibition of Discrimination, Law on Personal Data Protection, Law on State Audit Institution, Law on Public Procurement and Law on the Anti-Corruption Agency have been analyzed. It should be noted that the competencies of the ministries/specific independent state bodies were considered in the broadest sense, so that this overview only provides information about which ministries/specific independent state bodies **might be** related to the activities aimed at achieving a goal, without any suggestion on the allocation of real commitments.

In the second case the relation between UN Goals and qualitative strategy goals, as they are presented in the relevant strategic documents, has been analysed. Again it is not suggested that certain strategies must be used as public policy tools to achieve certain goal, but an **overview of meaningful links** between global and national development goals is provided.

It should be noted finally that the 14th Sustainable Development Goal - **Conserve and Sustainably Use Oceans, Seas and Marine Resources for Sustainable Development**, was left out of the overview for obvious reasons
